We are proposing that a building be built that will offer classrooms or small meeting rooms, a gymnasium or multipurpose room and sports center, kitchen with a snack area, as well as, storage for tables and chairs.

Why..... The tradition of Fairmont City has been to look to the future for the benefit of our children and those who are yet to come. With the closing of our one and only education and social center last year, all organized youth programs closed to some 250 children. There is neither a gymnasium nor a community center that welcomes these children. Even the afterschool programs are not available to them because there are no buses after 3:30 PM. Where can a child go for help with school work, learn to play basketball and soccer with the best sportsmanship, keep physically fit, know more about nutrition, take part in cultural events, and establish a work ethic that will make them productive citizens in the community.

Where..... The location of the CAC is yet to be determined. But it will be in the Village of Fairmont City.

How.....We need you! We can have that kind of unity and strong family values with a little work from everyone. We've already begun with a volunteer tutoring group after school at the Fairmont Library during this past school year. This tutoring will begin again in September. Watch the Library sign. But the real plan to initiate change for the young people of Fairmont City is to build.
